WHAT ARE WE VOTING FOR?

Several parishes will be conducting runoff elections for regularly-scheduled municipal primaries that were held in March. Additionally, some parishes will hold runoffs for special election primaries that were held in March, in order to fill vacant seats.

Several parishes will have local propositions on the ballot, in which eligible residents may vote *yes* or *no* on whether to pass certain bonds, debts, or taxes, amend local charters, recall an elected official, etc.

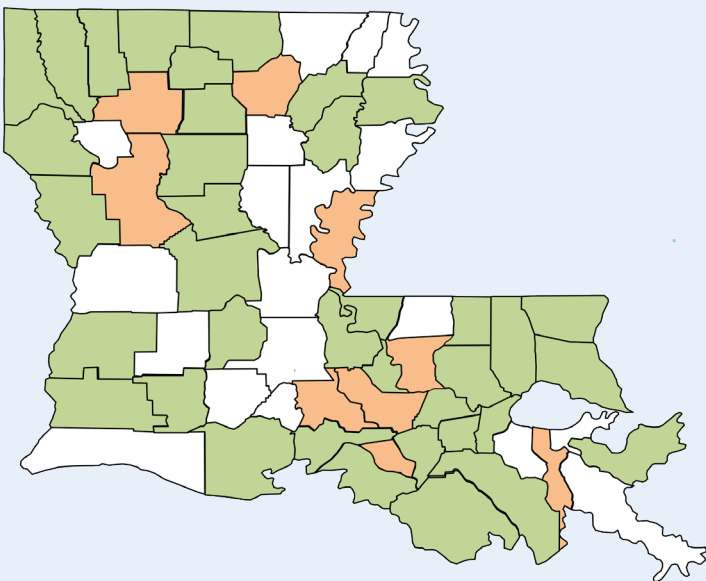

LOUISIANA AT A GLANCE

- 37 parishes will have local propositions only on the ballot:** Ascension, Assumption, Beauregard, Bossier, Caddo, Calcasieu, Claiborne, DeSoto, Evangeline, Franklin, Grant, Iberia, Jackson, Jefferson Davis, Lafourche, Lincoln, Livingston, Madison, Pointe Coupee, Rapides, Richland, Sabine, St. Bernard, St. Helena, St. James, St. John, St. Mary, St. Tammany, Tangipahoa, Terrebonne, Union, Vermilion, Washington, Webster, West Baton Rouge, West Feliciana, and Winn.
- 8 parishes will have both local propositions and local runoff elections on the ballot:** Bienville, Concordia, East Baton Rouge, Iberville, Jefferson, Natchitoches, Ouachita, and St. Martin.
- 19 parishes will have no elections:** Acadia, Allen, Avoyelles, Caldwell, Cameron, Catahoula, East Carroll, East Feliciana, Lafayette, LaSalle, Morehouse, Orleans, Plaquemines, Red River, St. Charles, St. Landry, Tensas, Vernon, and West Carroll.
